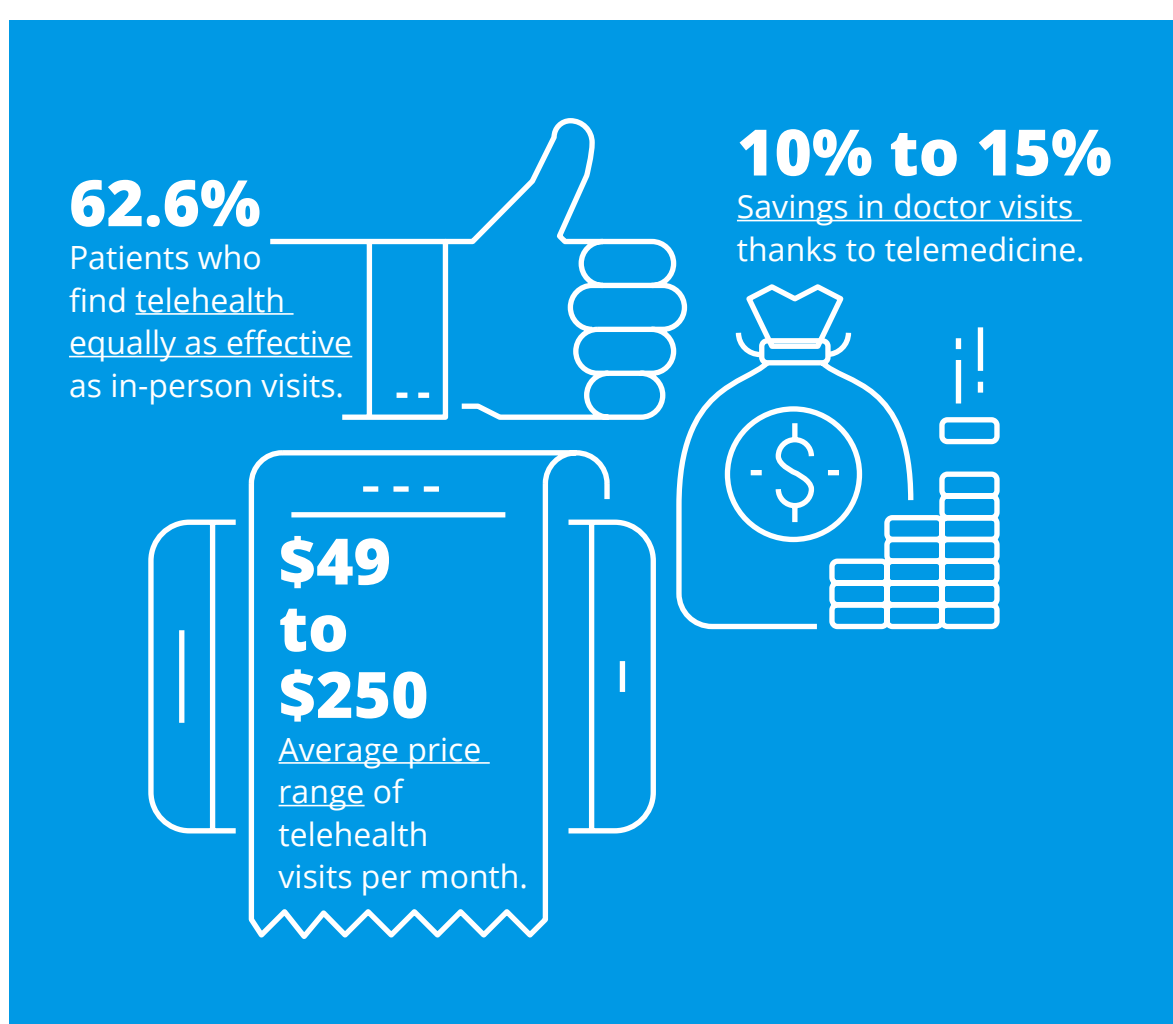
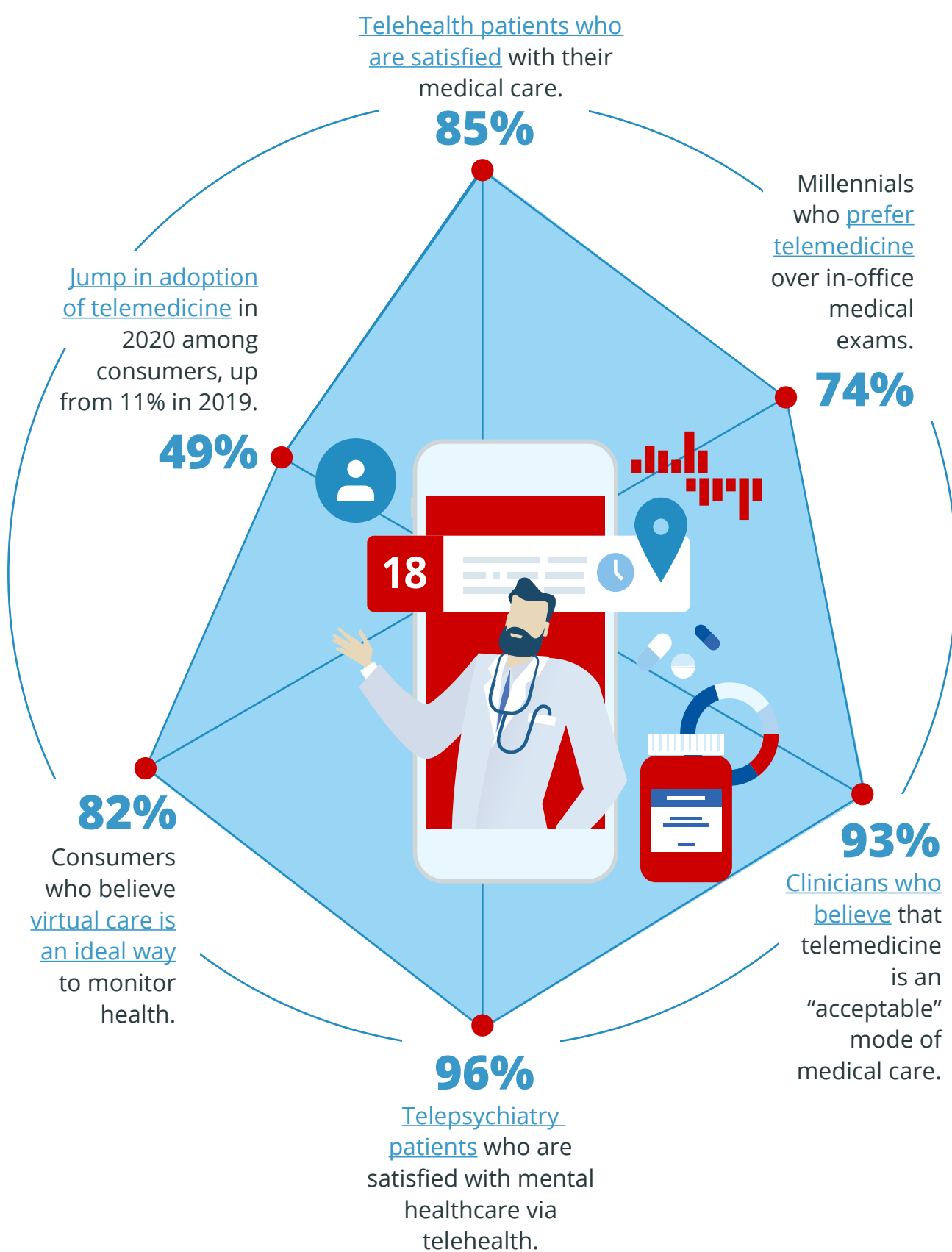




## Telehealth in 2021: Where We Are Now
